POSITION DESCRIPTION & RESPONSIBILITIES:

The ESL Program Assistant will assist the ESL Facilitator in the delivery of classes for multicultural men and women new to Canada who are wishing to improve their communication skills.

We are recruiting for new volunteers for the next term – September to June 2019. These volunteers are needed specifically from Monday mornings from 9:45 am to 11:15 am as a part of our English for Living in Canada program. This is textbook style teaching with focus on all ESL skills (reading, writing, listening, & speaking.)

CERTIFICATION OR EDUCATION REQUIRED:

- Certificate in teaching or TESOL is helpful but not necessary.
- Once accepted must complete general volunteer orientation, paperwork and screening process which includes but is not limited to a Vulnerable Sector Police Check.

REQUIRED SKILLS or INTERESTS:

This volunteer must:

- have a good grasp of English language and speak English clearly,
- have knowledge of phonics and English grammar,
- English as a second language training is an asset
- be patient and understanding of other cultures,
- be able to teach using a set program in a small group setting.
- take direction from the Adult Education Facilitator to assist those who attend classes.
