This temporary position provides sanitation, cleaning, and custodial service to custodial standards; ensuring that the building environment is healthy and comfortable.

Hours/Schedule

Full Time – 40 hours per week - Thursday to Sunday 12:30 p.m to 9:00 p.m.

Key Responsibilities

- Cleaning, sanitizing, sweeping, dusting, mopping, washing, vacuuming, polishing and waxing floors
- Cleaning windows, mirrors, woodwork, furniture, equipment and other surfaces
- Cleaning toilet facilities and keeping rooms, washrooms, offices, classrooms and other rooms supplied with towels, soap, and other items
- Emptying trash bins and disposing of trash into the garbage compactor or garbage bin

- Cleaning, sterilizing and/or disinfecting areas and/or equipment
- Organizing and maintaining janitorial supplies in janitorial room(s) and on janitorial carts
- Lifting and moving furniture as requested
- Performing laundry service when requested

Required Competencies

Education and Experience:

- High School Certificate.
- At least three months prior janitorial / housekeeping experience.
- Prior experience in using industrial cleaning equipment and chemicals.

Required Skills:

- Able to work in a team environment with minimal supervision.
- Able work with vulnerable people in a compassionate, non-judgmental manner.
- Desire to support the Mission of The Salvation Army.

Other combinations of education and/or experience may be considered.

Successful candidates, prior to hiring, may be required to provide:

- Background check consent.
- A satisfactory Police Information Check (PIC) with Vulnerable Sector search
- Child Intervention Check
- A proof of successful completion of our online Armatus Abuse Training, and required Health and Safety training.

In support of our commitment to a healthy and safe workplace and community, The Salvation Army (TSA) has a vaccination requirement for all employees in Canada. The successful candidate will be made an offer of employment on the condition of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and will be required to provide proof of full vaccination, prior to their employment start date. The requirement to be fully vaccinated is subject to provincial/territorial human rights legislation. If the candidate is unable to vaccinate for a reason protected by the Human Rights Code, a request for accommodation can be submitted and written proof satisfactory to TSA will be required.
