Position Type: Temporary Full Time – 40 hours per week

Position Summary

This temporary Facilities Technician will be responsible for various maintenance, grounds-keeping and custodial duties such as; providing assistance with the maintenance and repair of the building exterior and interior, physical plant and all building systems and the surrounding grounds.

Hours/Schedule

Full Time – 40 hours per week.

Rotating schedule of 8 hours per day 5 days per week and work days can be any of the 7 week days.

Shift is typically between 7:00a.m. and 11:00p.m. but may include a 4:00a.m. start during heavy snow falls.

What you will do:

- Completes repairs, maintenance and preventative tasks

- Assists supervisor with regular review of the condition of the facilities
- Provides daily log and required records as directed by the supervisor
- Resolves minor troubleshooting of building systems and completes adjustments/required repairs as assigned
- Cleans, maintains, and services equipment and tools
- Organizes and maintains supplies required for site operation, takes inventory count
- Ensures external property is in a safe and clean condition in all seasons for pedestrians and vehicles by removing snow/ice from sidewalks and parking lots, cleaning sidewalks, and removing litter
- Maintains the grounds in a tidy and clean condition by mowing lawns, raking and weeding, pruning shrubs and trees, watering plants
- Completes adjustments and required repairs to The Salvation Army standards and in accordance with maintenance procedures
- Safely operates all assigned company vehicles and related equipment
- Performs custodial tasks in accordance with Custodial Standard Operation and Safety Manual

What you will bring:

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License and proof of excellent driving record
- Standard First Aid/CPR Certification (can be obtained after hire)
- WHMIS Certificate (can be obtained after hire)
- Vertical Mast Lift Training
- Minimum one (1) year related experience in building operations, including heat plant, HVAC and general repairs
- One (1) year experience in year-round grounds-keeping
- At least six months experience in custodial duties
- Experience in performing a wide range of mechanical maintenance tasks and building repairs
- Able to pass a provide a satisfactory Police Information Check
- Desire to support the mission and core values of The Salvation Army.

Successful candidates, prior to hiring, may be required to provide:

- Background check consent.
- A satisfactory Police Information Check (PIC) with Vulnerable Sector search
- Child Intervention Check
- A proof of successful completion of our online Armatus Abuse Training, and required Health and Safety training.

In support of our commitment to a healthy and safe workplace and community, The Salvation Army (TSA) has a vaccination requirement for all employees in Canada. The successful candidate will be made an offer of employment on the condition of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and will be required to provide proof of full vaccination, prior to their employment start date. The requirement to be fully vaccinated is subject to provincial/territorial human rights legislation. If the candidate is unable to vaccinate for a reason protected by the Human Rights Code, a request for accommodation can be submitted and written proof satisfactory to TSA will be required.


